SUBJECT: 2018-2022 KMPO TIP Amendment #12 KN 19833 US 95, North Corridor Access Improvement Project

KMPO 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment #12, is to increase Land Purchase and Right of Way funds for KN19883 US 95, N Corridor Access Improvement Project.

KMPO is administratively amending the 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program to reflect a \$1,000,000 increase in funding for KN19883 US 95, North Corridor Access Improvement Project. This will increase funding for activities for right of way and land purchase. The project is currently within the existing 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program and does not impact fiscal constraint, nor does it modify the existing scope of the project.
