**KMPO 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment #3, Administrative Amendment to increase the programmed construction funding by \$290,000 as authorized by the Urban Balancing Committee 4/5/2018.**

KMPO is administratively amending the 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program to reflect an increase in construction funding to offset additional project costs as a result the recent bid opening. The project is currently within the existing 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program and does not impact fiscal constraint, nor does it modify the existing scope of the project.
