KMPO 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment #5, Administrative Amendment to delay the programmed construction funding from FY 2018 to FY 2019

KMPO is administratively amending the 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program to reflect a requested delay in construction funding from FY 2018 to FY 2019 as a result of additional time for environmental and right of way acquisition. The project is currently within the existing 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program and does not impact fiscal constraint, nor does it modify the existing scope of the project.
